Drought Management and Mitigation in CA

Within the framework of the UNCCD Secretariat funded pilot project "Regional Approaches in Combating Sand and Dust Storms and Drought in Central Asia", CAREC is initiating a thematic workshop to discuss the current draft of the "Regional Drought Risk Management Strategy for Central Asia" and Project concept for the Drought Monitoring and Early Warning System (DMEWS) develop in cooperation with the International Center for Biosaline Agriculture.

The goal of the project is to enable an environment for coordinated actions and data sharing at national and regional levels and informed decision-making in addressing drought and SDS related events in the Central Asian Region, by building on the momentum generated by the UNCCD Drought Initiative and linking it to the ongoing regional and international drought and climate change related initiatives.

The main objectives of the meeting are to receive strategic feedback, comments and recommendations of international development partners on the approaches, focus, and objectives of the "Regional Drought Risk Management Strategy for Central Asia", present the DMEWS tool, and discuss the ongoing initiatives and development agendas pertaining to the drought and climate change related events management.
